

Senate Bill #1633

Title: Elections By-law Amendment

Date: March 14, 1989

Sponsors: Constitution Committee

1. Whereas Article III, Section 1 of the ASUW Constitution states that a
2. student shall be a member of the ASUW "when payment or remission of
3. registration fees is made in the amount specified by the University to be
4. recognized as and accorded the privileges of a full-time student;" and
5. whereas Article III, Section 2 states that members of the ASUW "shall be
6. entitled to take part in and vote on matters of issue or consideration
7. before ASUW;" and whereas this is in direct conflict with Article III,
8. Section D of the ASUW by-laws which state that only full-time students
9. shall be permitted to vote; be it enacted by the Student Senate of the
10. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that it amend Article
11. III, Section D of the ASUW by-laws to read, "Voters: any full-fee paying
12. student shall be permitted to vote after presenting his current
13. student identification card at a designated voting area."
