

Senate Bill #1640

Title: Establishment of Non-traditional Council

Date: April 18, 1989

Sponsors: Suzanne Taheri, Doug Hecox, Chris Spooner

1. Whereas the ASUW Senate, as a legislative body representing the entire
2. student body of the University of Wyoming, has a responsibility to see
3. that the interests of all students are represented and that all students
4. can participate in meaningful activities sponsored with their student
5. fees; whereas the University of Wyoming population of students entering
6. the University for the first time or returning back to the University
7. several years after their graduation from high school is increasing;
8. whereas the concerns of these students may not always be expressed
9. successfully to ASUW Senators; and whereas the creation of a council
10. would provide a forum to make their views more accessible to the ASUW
11. Senate; be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of
12. the University of Wyoming that a Non-traditional Council, that would be
13. open to all interested "non-traditional" students with an advisor from
14. the ASUW Senate, be established to voice concerns of "non-traditional"
15. students and to act as an advisory body to the ASUW Senate through an ex-
16. officio position. Furthermore, be it enacted that the by-laws of the
17. ASUW be amended at Article II, Section 6, Part B by adding "Non-
18. traditional Council Representative."
