


1. WHEREAS, University of Wyoming students and the University of Wyoming
2. are affected by federal policies and funding; and
3. WHEREAS, the availability of financial aid, in many cases, influences
4. students to continue education after high school; and
5. WHEREAS, the proposed federal budget on higher education will
6. effectively deny assistance to thousands of students who are eligible
7. for aid under current programs;
8. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated
9. Students of the University of Wyoming that federal budget cuts
10. adversely affecting students receiving federal financial aid and
11. participating in work-study programs should be restored without
12. detriment to other higher education programs;
13. Be it further resolved that the ASUW President will furnish the
14. Wyoming legislative delegation with copies of this Resolution.
