Title: ASUW Student Activities Advisory Board

Sponsors: Student Activities Advisory Board

1. WHEREAS, the purpose, powers and composition of the Student
2. Activities Advisory Board should be modified to better imitate
3. its actual procedures and better represent ASUW's needs;
4. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the
5. University of Wyoming that the ASUW Constitution be amended,
6. through a referendum placed on the general election ballot for
7. the 1992 ASUW Election, so that Article VI, Section 6,
8. Paragraph I, Subsection 1, has the following addition:
9. "...through the use of unanticipated programming funds.";
10. Be it further enacted that Article VI, Section 6, Paragraph I,
11. Subsections 2 & 3 be deleted and replaced with the following:
12. "2. Powers. The Student Activities Advisory Board shall
13. have the responsibility of considering the requests of
14. recognized student organizations for ASUW unanticipated
15. programming funds; recommending Senate action on such
16. requests; and the authority to administer the ASUW
17. Finance Policy pursuant to budget allocations of such
18. funds. Additionally, this Board shall establish such
19. standards of operation and procedure as are necessary to
20. maintain proper accountability and effective use of funds
21. allocated in this manner. The Student Activities

22. Advisory Board shall provide aid in the promotion of ASUW  
23. Activities to the ASUW Government; and shall bring to the  
24. ASUW Government any substantial concerns or issues that  
25. ASUW Activities may encounter.

26. Composition. The ASUW Student Activities Advisory Board  
27. shall consist of a minimum of five ASUW Senators, one to  
28. act as Chair, appointed by the Vice President of  
29. ASUW and approved by the Senate; a minimum of five  
30. students selected as representatives from each ASUW  
31. Activities Commission; advisors being the Assistant  
32. Director of the Wyoming Union Programs and Services  
33. and the ASUW Business Manager; and as ex-officio  
34. members, the Union Program Specialist, the ASUW Program  
35. Specialists, an Ethnic Minority Council representative,  
36. and a Non-Traditional Student Council representative.  
37. The ASUW Activities secretary will attend the meetings to  
38. take minutes."
