1. WHEREAS, the Campus Master Plan has been issued from the
2. Facilities Planning Office for Trustee approval; and
3. WHEREAS, the Trustees have asked for student input into the
4. proposals in the Campus Master Plan; and
5. WHEREAS, the entire student body will be greatly affected by
6. the changes introduced in the Campus Master Plan; and
7. WHEREAS, the future of fraternity and sorority rows are left
8. unclear due to their designation as "multiple use" areas; and
9. WHEREAS, each building in these areas is primarily designed to
10. be a housing unit used by a Greek organization; and
11. WHEREAS, the University is entertaining the thoughts of
12. expansion of the Greek system and these potential new members
13. would desire and need these available buildings;
14. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the
15. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that ASUW
16. does not support the designation of fraternity and sorority
17. rows as "multiple use" areas but does support a classification
18. of these areas as "housing/residential".
