Title: Scholastic Probation: Unireg 715, Revision 2,  
Section 1, Paragraph (b)

1. WHEREAS, an undergraduate student must have a 2.00 cumulative
2. grade point average in order to receive a degree; and
3. WHEREAS, it is currently possible for students to be in "good
4. academic standing with less than a 2.00 GPA"; and
5. WHEREAS, many scholarships and financial aid awards are
6. dependent upon a 2.00 GPA; and
7. WHEREAS, Freshmen need some academic adjustment period;
8. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the
9. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that we
10. support the change in Unireg 715, Revision 2, Section 1,
11. Paragraph (b) as proposed by the Faculty Senate, which reads:
12.       b. A student enrolled at the University shall be
13.           placed on scholastic probation at the end of
14.           the semester or summer session when his/her
15.           cumulative grade point average at the University
16.           of Wyoming falls below a 2.00 GPA with the following
17.           provision:
18.           Students under 30 credit hours shall have two
19.           semesters of scholastic probation before academic
20.           suspension.
