- 10. support the change in Unireq 715, Revision 2, Section 1,
- 11. Paragraph (b) as proposed by the Faculty Senate, which reads:
- 12. b. A student enrolled at the University shall be
- 13. placed on scholastic probation at the end of
- 14. the semester or summer session when his/her
- 15. cumulative grade point average at the University
- 16. of Wyoming falls below a 2.00 GPA with the following
- 17. provision:
- 18. Students under 30 credit hours shall have two
- 19. semesters of scholastic probation before academic
- 20. suspension.
