1 WHEREAS, students rely on midterm grade reports to verify
2 class standing; and

3 WHEREAS, professors are currently not required to submit a
4 midterm grade report to Registration and Records; and

5 WHEREAS, approximately forty-five percent of the professors do
6 not report deficient grades at midterm; and

7 WHEREAS, an accurate and informative approach to reporting
8 grades will be beneficial and productive in creating more
9 communication and a better relationship between the professor,
10 advisor, and the student; and


11 WHEREAS, verification of students' academic progress at mid-
12 term will help to increase the level of retention at the
13 University; and

14 WHEREAS, deficient mid-term grades will encourage students to
15 seek assistance or guidance from professors and advisors;

16 THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the
17 Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that we
18 support the mandatory reporting of all mid-term grades, A
19 through F, for all University courses, as outlined in the
20 attached mid-term grade evaluation report. See addendum.


