

SENATE BILL #1777

Title: ASUW Fee Increase
Date: September 30, 1994
Authors: Budget and Planning Committee
Sponsors: Senators Catchpole, Cotton, Friedl, Kalasinsky,
Krug, and Mathes

1 WHEREAS, the ASUW fee has not been increased since 1982; and
2 WHEREAS, the costs associated with funding ASUW programs and
3 services significantly increase with every fiscal year; and
4 WHEREAS, the variety and scope of ASUW programming and
5 services have broadened significantly since the last fee
6 increase; and
7 WHEREAS, the base population of fee-paying students has
8 declined from over 8500 to less than 8250 students, further
9 constricting the ASUW budget; and
10 WHEREAS, ASUW funded salaries have increased by \$37,123
11 since 1989; and
12 WHEREAS, the ASUW Budget and Planning Committee was forced
13 to remove over \$80,000 from the ASUW Reserve in order to
14 balance the budgets for fiscal years 1994 and 1995;
15 THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the
16 University of Wyoming Senate that the ASUW fee be raised
17 from \$16.75 to \$25.00 per semester for fiscal year 1996; and
18 THEREFORE be it further enacted that the ASUW Budget and
19 Planning Committee be required to review and report to the
20 ASUW Senate on the adequacy of the amount of the ASUW fee

21 not less than every two years (see addendum).
