Title: Freshman Council Name Change
Date: October 14, 1994
Authors: Consumer Committee
Sponsors: Senators Baim, Drane, King, Krone, and Paul

1 WHEREAS, Freshman Council will be moving toward more of an
2 issue centered organization; and
3 WHEREAS, the term "senate" is associated with a higher level
4 of professionalism and degree of seriousness than "council";
5 and
6 WHEREAS, the trend at the University of Wyoming is for
7 representative organizations to change their name from
8 "council" to "senate"; and
9 WHEREAS, the existing Freshman Council voted overwhelmingly
10 in favor of a name change from Freshman Council to Freshman
11 Senate; and
12 WHEREAS, this organization is referred to in the Associated
13 Students of the University of Wyoming By-Laws as Freshman
14 Council;
15 THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the
16 Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that the
17 name Freshman Council be changed to Freshman Senate.
18 THEREFORE, be it further enacted that Article II, Section 6,
19 Subsection B #8 be changed from "Freshman Council
20 Representative" to "Freshman Senate Representative."
