1 WHEREAS, the organization currently known as Ethnic Minority
2 Council unanimously voted in favor of a name change which
3 better represents their current directives; and
4 WHEREAS, Ethnic Minority Council has requested that their
5 name be changed to "United Multicultural Council";
6 THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the
7 Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that
8 "Minority Council Representative" be stricken and "United
9 Multicultural Council Representative" added to Article II,
10 Section 6, Subsection B, number 10 in the ASUW By-Laws.
