Title: Public Relations Committee Change

1 WHEREAS, the primary purpose of ASUW legislative committees  
2 is to research, discuss, and formulate legislation based on  
3 issues of student concern; and  
4 WHEREAS, the Public Relations Committee of the ASUW does not  
5 have legislative formulation as its purpose; and  
6 WHEREAS, the goals of public relations would be best  
7 accomplished by an executive assistant in the Executive  
8 Branch of ASUW; and  
9 WHEREAS, an executive assistant in the Executive Branch  
10 currently performs public relations tasks;  
11 THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the  
12 Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that  
13 Article VI, Section 6, Subsection L of the ASUW Constitution  
14 and the words "and Public Relations" from Article II,  
15 Section 11, Letter A of the ASUW By-Laws be stricken and the  
16 word "and" be inserted between "Board" and "Research"; and  
17 THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the duties and  
18 responsibilities of the Public Relations Committee be  
19 assumed by an executive assistant in the Executive Branch  
20 and a minimum of two senators who are appointed as assistants.
