

SENATE RESOLUTION #1774

Title: Preservation of Homecoming Royalty

1 WHEREAS, Cardinal Key's budget application for FY95 states
2 "a major part of Homecoming is the royalty selection. With
3 the support of ASUW, 1993 Homecoming Royalty selection was a
4 success, which did not go unnoticed by UW administrators and
5 alumni."; and

6 WHEREAS, Cardinal Key has proposed to substitute the
7 traditional method of Homecoming King and Queen selection
8 with the fundamentally different UW Gold program; and

9 WHEREAS, the traditional method of Homecoming King and Queen
10 selection provides the student population with the final
11 decision to recognize outstanding student individuals on
12 campus as Homecoming King and Queen and their attendants;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, the proposed UW Gold program only provides 50% of
15 the selection vote to the student population, while giving
16 50% of the selection vote to a designated panel; and

17 WHEREAS, the Cardinal Key decision to utilize a panel of
18 judges which carries equal weight with student vote devalues
19 student opinion in the process; and

20 WHEREAS, ASUW Budget and Planning specifically allocated
21 \$265 to Cardinal Key from the student-generated ASUW fee in

22 order to promote Homecoming King and Queen selection;
23 THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the
24 Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that we do
25 not endorse the UW Gold program initiated by Cardinal Key
26 Junior Honorary.
