Title: Academic Advising Evaluations

1 WHEREAS, the students of the University of Wyoming presently
2 have no standard method for evaluating academic advisor
3 performance; and
4 WHEREAS, student success should be the highest priority at the
5 University of Wyoming; and
6 WHEREAS, effective academic advising is a vital part of that
7 success; and
8 WHEREAS, students must have firm knowledge of degree and
9 University Studies requirements in order to graduate from the
10 University in a timely manner; and
11 WHEREAS, students are concerned that the quality of academic
12 advising at the University of Wyoming is not up to a level of
13 expected excellence;
14 THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the
15 Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that ASUW
16 supports the development of academic advising evaluation
17 standards at the University of Wyoming.
