

SENATE RESOLUTION #1800

Title: Proposed Revisions to Unireg 239  
Date: October 16, 1995  
Authors: Budget and Planning Committee

1 WHEREAS, Unireg 239 establishes the ASUW Fee; and  
2 WHEREAS, the current language of Unireg 239 does not reflect  
3 the dynamic nature of the ASUW Fee; and  
4 WHEREAS, the ASUW Fee must be reviewed annually in order to  
5 most successfully accommodate the needs of the Associated  
6 Students of the University of Wyoming; and  
7 WHEREAS, the Fee Book is established and reviewed annually  
8 before it is approved by the University of Wyoming Board of  
9 Trustees;  
10 THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the  
11 Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that section  
12 4 of Unireg 239 reads as follows:

13 4. Amount of ASUW Fee: The amount of the ASUW Fee  
14 shall be established by the Trustees. The Student  
15 Senate may initiate requests for changes in the  
16 amount. All concerned must recognize that the cost  
17 to students for educational opportunities at the  
18 University should be as low as possible and that  
19 consideration must be given to all University  
20 programs which are dependent upon student fees for  
21 support as a part of total resources available.

22           The amount of the ASUW fee shall be reviewed  
23           annually by the Student Senate of the Associated  
24           Students of the University of Wyoming and by the  
25           University of Wyoming Board of Trustees. After  
26           approval by those bodies, the official amount of  
27           the ASUW Fee shall be recorded in the Fee Book for  
28           the current fiscal year.
