Title: Academic Integrity

1 WHEREAS, the academic integrity of an institution is directly
2 influenced by the academic integrity of its individual
3 students; and
4 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the student body,
5 faculty, and administration to maintain an honorable and
6 respected academic program; and
7 WHEREAS, it is desirable to develop open lines of
8 communication to discuss academic integrity and discourage
9 dishonesty;
10 THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the
11 Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that we
12 encourage the use of "A Statement on Academic Integrity" as
13 a preface to University publications, including the general
14 bulletins and semester schedules, as well as course syllabi
15 (see addendum).
