Title: ASUW Student Government Optional Credit Program

1 WHEREAS, it is beneficial to provide students with the
2 opportunity to further their experiences with the Associated
3 Students of the University of Wyoming by allowing more
4 academic application of student's participation in ASUW
5 Student Senate; and

6 WHEREAS, an optional credit program would provide a better
7 understanding among student senators, executives, and ex-
8 officios of the responsibility and time commitment involved
9 with participating in ASUW Student Senate; and

10 WHEREAS, the credit would allow potential employers and/or
11 graduate institutions to see, by looking at a student's
12 transcript, a student's extracurricular participation and the
13 importance placed upon it by the University of Wyoming; and

14 WHEREAS, this program would be listed under University Studies
15 as Student Government Leadership Internship - 3000; and

16 WHEREAS, an optional one credit ^{hour} per semester ^{for a maximum of 4 semesters,} would be offered
17 for students completing a project relating to their experience
18 in ASUW along with meeting his or her ASUW student senator, or
19 executive officer, ^{ex-officio} obligations; and

20 WHEREAS, students would enter into a learning contract to
21 obtain credit; and

22 WHEREAS, students would receive "Satisfactory" or

23 "Unsatisfactory" grades issued by the ^{ASUW} advisor ~~to ASUW~~; and
24 WHEREAS, ASUW student senators, executive officers, and ex-
25 officios to the ASUW Student Senate would be eligible to
26 participate;
27 THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the
28 Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that we
29 support the implementation of an ASUW Student Government
30 Optional Credit program (see addendum).
