

SENATE BILL #1858

Title: Campus Activities Center Restructuring

Date: April 29, 1997

1 WHEREAS, ASUW has a desire to streamline its operations and decrease its budgetary
2 dependence on salaries; and

3 WHEREAS, the Wyoming Union is seeking to reorganize the Campus Activities
4 Center in order to decrease overhead and improve services; and

5 WHEREAS, this reorganization will benefit the ASUW, Wyoming Union, and the
6 general student population by increasing the quantity and quality of programming and
7 activities supported and initiated by the Campus Activity Center and ASUW; and

8 WHEREAS, the two ASUW Program Specialist salaries are currently fully funded by
9 ASUW; and

10 WHEREAS, the current ASUW budget responsibility for salaries in the Campus
11 Activities Center is \$52,296.00.

12 THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
13 University of Wyoming, that the budgetary allocation for one Program Specialist salary
14 be decreased to 88.5% of the current allocation and the other Program Specialist Salary
15 continue to be fully funded at the FY98 Budget level; and

16 THEREFORE, be it further enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students
17 of the University of Wyoming, that the decrease in allocation of \$2500.00 for the
18 salary of one Program Specialist be offset by a salary appropriation of \$2500.00 for
19 this individual by the Wyoming Union; and

20 THEREFORE, be it further enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students
21 of the University of Wyoming, that any increase in salary and/or benefits for these two
22 positions caused by a promotion or increase in title or responsibilities be the
23 responsibility of the Wyoming Union; and

24 THEREFORE, be it further enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students
25 of the University of Wyoming, that the total ASUW budgetary responsibility for
26 salaries in the Campus Activities Center be reduced to \$41,132.00, effective fiscal year
27 1998. (See Addendum)

Proposed Reorganization Plan

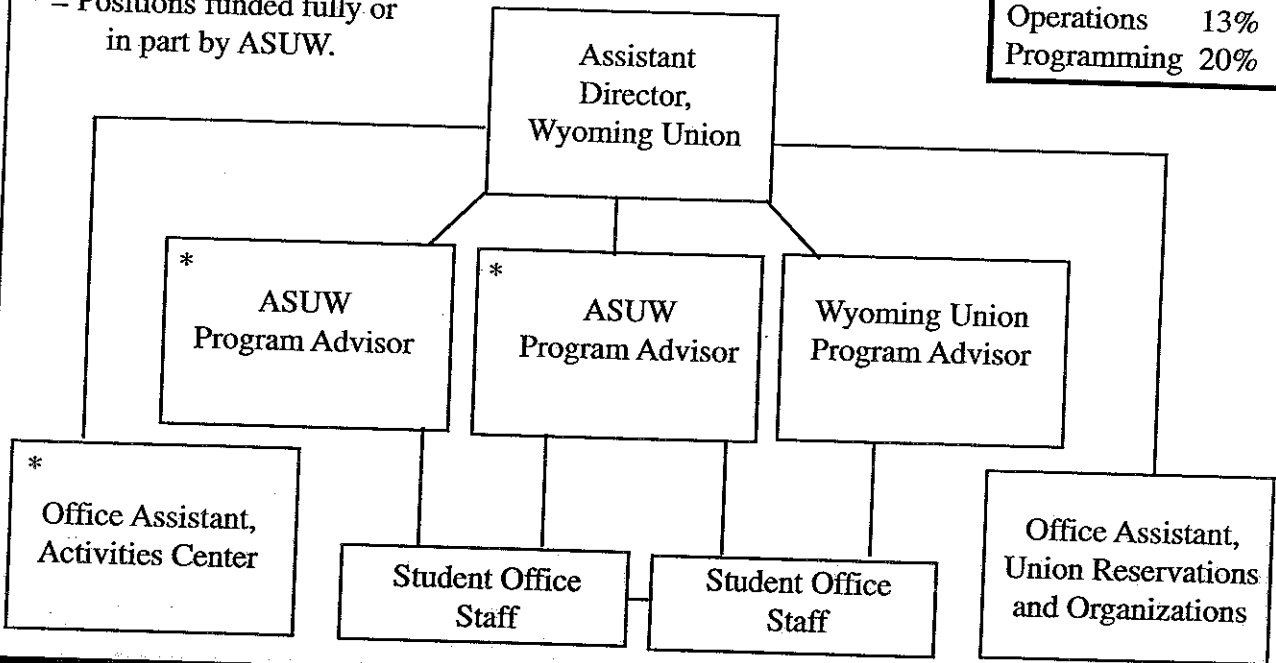
CURRENT STRUCTURE:
