Title: Students' Attorney Advisory Board Adjustments


1. WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Associated Students of the University of
2. Wyoming mandates that the Students' Attorney Advisory Board be composed of
3. seven students appointed by the ASUW President in addition to the student
4. senator from the College of Law; and
5. WHEREAS, the number of students appointed may be excessive for the purpose of
6. the committee.
7. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
8. University of Wyoming, that the Student Senate proposes that Article VI, Section 6,
9. paragraph J, subparagraph 2 of the ASUW Constitution be amended to read as
10. follows: "...advice and consent of the ASUW Student Senate and review..."
11. THEREFORE, be it further enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students
12. of the University of Wyoming, that the Student Senate proposes that Article VI,
13. Section 6, paragraph J, subparagraph 3 of the ASUW Constitution be amended to
14. read as follows: "...be composed of the student senator from the College of Law and
15. a minimum of four students appointed by the ASUW President..."
