

SENATE BILL #1874

Title: Changes to ASUW By-Laws

**Sponsors: Senators Anthes, Bales, Bashor, Bates, Bean, Benedick, Rice, Thyne,
and Tufts**

1. WHEREAS, Article III of the ASUW By-Laws needs to be updated; and
2. WHEREAS, several parts are contradictory.
3. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of
4. the University of Wyoming that Article III, Elections, of the ASUW By-Laws be
5. amended to read as follows: Article III, B-5 – strike ‘In such case. . . general
6. election.’; Article III, C-6, and C-6 (a) strike “The number. . . college.”; C-6 shall
7. read “The number of candidates shall not exceed twice the number of senators
8. for that college, unless there is a tie for the last place in that college, in which case
9. all candidates will be allowed in the general election”; F-1 (b) to read “He must
10. have a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average if an undergraduate, 3.0
11. cumulative grade point average if a graduate or professional student, unless such
12. a cumulative grade point average is not required by his particular graduate or
13. professional program; F-2 (a) shall read as follows: “Only a full-time
14. undergraduate or law student with a 2.0 cumulative grade point average, or a full
15. time graduate student with a 3.0 cumulative grade point average shall be eligible.
16. Undergraduate students must have attained junior class standing or higher the
17. semester following the election to be eligible.”
