

SENATE BILL #1907

Title: University President's Time Frame On Judicial Council Decisions

Date: February 19, 1999

Sponsors: Senators Eicke, Gill, Nelson, Tu, and Tufts

1. WHEREAS, the University President is the only authority over the ASUW
2. Judicial Council (ASUW Constitution, Article 8, Section 3-A); and
3. WHEREAS, ASUW Judicial Council decisions are often of a timely nature; and
4. WHEREAS, the ASUW Judicial Council "must meet upon the complaint within
5. ten (10) school days" (ASUW Constitution, Article 8, Section 5); and
6. WHEREAS, the University President currently has no time frame on which to
7. respond to Judicial Council's decisions.
8. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of
9. Wyoming that Article 8, Section 3-A of the ASUW Constitution be changed to
10. read as follows: "Subject to the approval of the University President, the ASUW
11. Judicial Council shall be the final authority in interpretations of the ASUW
12. Constitution and/or the ASUW By-Laws. If the University President has not
13. issued a written disapproval within 10 school days, the ASUW Judicial Council
14. decision will stand. If the President is unavailable he may appoint a designee to
15. act on his behalf."
