

SENATE BILL #1958

**Title:** What Do the People Want?

**Date:** October 27, 2000

**Authors:** Senators Johnson, Reed, and Smith; Student-at-Large Trenton McCaskill

**Sponsors:** Senators Bartels, Johnson, Partridge, Reed, Smith

1. WHEREAS, the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW)
2. are elected to represent the student body as a whole; and
3. WHEREAS, it is the advice of the Vice President of ASUW that senators
4. establish a minimum of one office hour per week; and
5. WHEREAS, ASUW would like to establish a more intimate relationship with
6. the student body as a whole in offering an interface for questions, comments,
7. and general feedback.
8. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students
9. of the University of Wyoming that a forum for student opinions be established
10. in the Wyoming Student Union; and
11. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that these forums be established on
12. alternating Wednesdays and Thursdays of each school week; and
13. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that these forums be known as "What Do
14. You Want Wednesday" and "Thinking Thursday."
