

SENATE RESOLUTION #1976

Title: Students' Attorney Program Revisions

1. WHEREAS, one of the primary responsibilities and duties of the Students'
2. Attorney Advisory Board is to make program recommendations with regard
3. to the Students' Attorney Program; and
4. WHEREAS, there is a demonstrated need for diverse programming within the
5. Students' Attorney Program.
6. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated
7. Students of the University of Wyoming that, contingent upon the passage of
8. Senate Bill #1972 by the general student body, the Students' Attorney
9. Advisory Board (hereinafter "Board") recommend the creation of an internet
10. web page; and
11. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Board advocate a shift in the
12. focus of the Students' Attorney Program to encompass a greater degree of
13. campus-wide programming, particularly regarding general legal education
14. (i.e., seminars, panel discussions, etc.); and
15. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Students' Attorney Program seek
16. independent grant funding from the Wyoming State Bar and other groups to
17. effectuate the increase in campus-wide programming; and
18. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Board explore the eventual

19. incorporation of a student internship to assist the Students Attorney and enrich
20. the student intern's educational experience; and
21. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Board update every Students'
22. Attorney publication every two (2) years; and
23. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that, in conjunction with the Office of
24. Student Life, the Board pursue training for individual Board members in the
25. administration of the Students' Attorney Program; and
26. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Students' Attorney Program
27. accentuate the paralegal nature of the Staff Assistant to help with the
28. advancement of programming and other legal services; and
29. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Board seeks alternative means
30. of funding the Students' Attorney Program (i.e., shifting the burden from
31. ASUW to the Office of Student Life).
