1. WHEREAS, the future of the Centennial Singers program is uncertain
2. because of the resignation of the director; and
3. WHEREAS, the current independent structure meets the needs of the
4. Centennial Singers; and
5. WHEREAS, the current membership is primarily composed of non-music
6. majors; and
7. WHEREAS, the relocation of the program to the music department would
8. result in budget constraints and limited participation of non-music majors; and
9. WHEREAS, the existence of Centennial Singers and the diverse academic
10. interests of the members makes Centennial Singers a valuable marketing tool
11. for the University, allowing for greater recruitment opportunities; and
12. WHEREAS, some potential students are drawn to and remain at the
13. University due to the uniqueness and rarity of the Centennial Singers program.
14. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated
15. Students of the University of Wyoming that the Student Senate does not
16. support the relocation of the Centennial Singers program to the Music
17. Department; and
18. THEREFORE, be it further resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated

19. Students of the University of Wyoming that the Student Senate supports the
20. continuance of the Centennial Singers program under its current
21. administration and the direct allocation of funding to the program.
