6. individual student grades; and
7. WHEREAS, students who wish to receive a hard copy of their grades can
8. continue to do so through the Office of the Registrar.

10. Wyoming that the student senate fully supports the cessation of mailing
11. student grades as proposed by the Office of the Registrar.
