1. WHEREAS, the current Students' Attorney Program has been a valuable
2. program for the students of the University of Wyoming; and
3. WHEREAS, the program has shown to be useful to students when confronted
4. with legal dilemmas; and
5. WHEREAS, Legal Services is a necessary program that the Associated
6. Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW) should have access to; and
7. WHEREAS, the current structure of the program does not allow the option of
8. litigation to be pursued; and
9. WHEREAS, the current cost of maintaining this program exceeds \$80,000
10. annually; and
11. WHEREAS, the program has the potential to be more efficient and more cost
12. effective if reviewed.
13. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students
14. of the University of Wyoming that the current structure of the Students'
15. Attorney program be examined and alternative programs be taken under
16. consideration; and
17. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the Students' Attorney Advisory
18. Board seek other avenues of service from local attorneys in order to explore

19. potential programming options.
