

SENATE RESOLUTION #2034

Title: Proposed Long-Term Fee Increases for FY04 (2003-04)

Date: February 12, 2003

1. WHEREAS, the costs of operations for the Wyoming Union have increased
2. from fiscal year (FY 2003, academic year 2002-03); and
3. WHEREAS, such rising costs and increased usage of Union facilities have
4. necessitated the addition of another custodian as well as a manager for the
5. Union Gardens and recreation area; and
6. WHEREAS, there has been a demonstrable increasing interest in late night
7. programming further necessitating the increase in length of time of the
8. program advisor position from ten (10) months to twelve (12) months; and
9. WHEREAS, operation expenditures for the Office of Campus Recreation
10. have also increased from FY 2003 due in large part to the transfer from
11. Section I to Section II salary funds as well as the addition of the Wellness
12. Center to the facilities provided by Half Acre Gym; and
13. WHEREAS, there has been a demonstrable increased usage of Campus
14. Recreation services necessitating an increase in the operational budget for
15. Club Sports, Intramural Sports, Open Recreation, and Outdoor Adventure
16. programs; and
17. WHEREAS, the needs and desires of the student body have grown to
18. accommodate expanded services from the Office of Student Health

19. Services (OSHS); and
20. WHEREAS, said services require an increase in the OSHS operational
21. budget including the addition of new staff members to occupy and manage
22. a new Student Services Office to be housed on the second floor of Half
23. Acre Gym.
24. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated
25. Students of the University of Wyoming that, in accordance with
26. Addendum A, we duly support the proposed long-term fee increases for
27. FY 2004 (academic year 2003-2004).
