1. WHEREAS, ASUW has recently settled into a new office space in the Union;
2. and
3. WHEREAS, recent ASUW legislation set the number of executive assistants
4. at six to serve on the Executive Branch of ASUW; and
5. WHEREAS, the current office resources are insufficient to support six
6. executive assistants; and
7. WHEREAS, the ASUW Executive Branch prides itself on productivity and
8. accountability; and
9. WHEREAS, each executive assistant is required to work at least 15 hours per
10. week; and
11. WHEREAS, work schedules for the executive assistants coincide; and
12. WHEREAS, the current office structure requires four of the executive
13. assistants to share work space; and
14. WHEREAS, one goal of ASUW is to see the future of ASUW from a long-
15. term perspective.
16. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students
17. of the University of Wyoming that \$5,700 be allocated from the ASUW
18. Equipment Reserve for the one-time costs associated with the addition of two

19. work spaces including office furniture and equipment.
