**Title:** Clarification of Impeachment Procedures

**Date:** March 29, 2004

**Authors:** Constitution Committee

**Sponsors:** Senators Chollak, R. Hernandez, Hughes, Kice, Owens, Rising

1. WHEREAS, the ASUW By-Laws provide for the removal of elected members
2. through an impeachment process; and
3. WHEREAS, the term impeachment refers only to the bringing of charges that
4. may result in the removal of an elected person from office; and
5. WHEREAS, an elected person can only be removed from office if convicted
6. on articles of impeachment; and
7. WHEREAS, the term impeachment is used improperly in the ASUW By-
8. Laws, Article VII, Section 11.
9. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students
10. of the University of Wyoming that the ASUW By-Laws, Article VII –
11. Impeachment, Section 11 be changed to the language of Addendum A.

Addendum A to Senate Bill #2076

New language to ASUW By-Laws, Article VII, Section 11

If convicted on articles of impeachment, there shall be no punishment other than removal from office.
