

SENATE BILL #2092

Title: Opening and Connecting ASUW to the Nation

Introduced: October 20, 2004

1. WHEREAS, the American Student Government Association ^(ASGA) provides all
2. student government leaders and advisors nationwide with networking,
3. research, and information resources and ~~will~~ ^{ES} teach them how to become more
4. effective, ethical, and influential leaders on their campuses; and
5. WHEREAS ^{write out} (ASUW) has raised the bar on legislative actions which calls for
6. additional research and a broader knowledge to which legislation relates; and
7. WHEREAS, the American Student Government Association ^(ASGA) has ^A databases of
8. ⁴⁷⁰⁰ over 400 universities and colleges throughout the nation which will help
9. ASUW solve pressing problems, boost ASUW's image, and earn more respect
10. from administrators, students, and the media; and
11. WHEREAS, American Student Government Association ^{ASGA} provides
12. supplemental information on improving voter turn-out, improving student
13. government image, and preventing administrators from side-stepping and
14. ~~delaying on~~ ASUW requests.
15. THEREFORE, be it enacted that the Associated Students of the University of
16. Wyoming will allocate \$1,256.00 to ASGA for a two year membership
17. entitling all of the benefits mentioned above; and
18. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that ^{\$1254} (these monies will) be taken from the

ASUW RESERVE

19. [Executive budget, namely \$628.00 from the Safe Ride reserve and the other

20. \$628.00 from the miscellaneous line item of the Student Legal Services] for

21. this two year trial program; and

22. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that after the two year trial basis, ASUW

23. Executive branch will assign a ^{STANDING} committee to review the utility of the program

24. and whether or not ASGA will become a line item expenditure. ^{IN THE ASUW BUDGET}
