Title: Senate Seat Allocation

1. WHEREAS, there is a necessity for the Associated Students of the University
2. of Wyoming (ASUW) Elections to have a standardized method for the
3. allocation of senate seats for each college; and
4. WHEREAS, there is no current system in place for the allocation of senate
5. seats; and
6. WHEREAS, there should be a standardized method for the allocation of the
7. allotted senate seats for each college.
8. THEREFORE, be it enacted that the Associated Students of the University of
9. Wyoming officially adopt the Hill-Huntington method for seat allocation;
10. and
11. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the ASUW Constitution be amended
12. to further denote the Hill-Huntington method as is shown in Addendum A.
