5. student community; and
6. WHEREAS, non-traditional students juggle several roles at once including
7. family education, community and church involvement, and employment; and
8. WHEREAS, non-traditional students add positively to the overall diversity
9. and life-experience of the University of Wyoming campus; and
10. WHEREAS, Wyoming Governor Dave Freudenthal has proclaimed the week
11. of November 6-12, 2005 as "Non-traditional Student Week" across the state
12. of Wyoming; and
13. WHEREAS, the week of November 6-12, 2005 is also celebrated nationally
14. as N.U.T.S. (Not the Usual Traditional Student) Week; and
15. WHEREAS, the Non-traditional Student Council, a service of the Associated
16. Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW), will host a variety of
17. awareness activities during that week.
