

**SENATE BILL #2173**

**Title: Creation of a special committee on transportation and parking**

**Date: March 28, 2007**

**Authors: Senators Heimann, Jensen, Watt**

**Sponsors: Senators Clay, Kelsey Day, Kautzsch, and Vogelmann**

1. WHEREAS, accessible parking and transportation are necessary to the University
2. of Wyoming; and
3. WHEREAS, students often voice concerns regarding parking and transportation
4. around the University of Wyoming; and
5. WHEREAS, parking issues will continue to increase with respect to the current
6. campus construction timeline; and
7. WHEREAS, the current Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
8. (ASUW) created an Ad-Hoc Committee on Parking which provides a venue to
9. research parking and transportation issues; and
10. WHEREAS, the ASUW Ad-Hoc Parking Committee has conducted useful
11. research in an effort to provide solutions to the issues at hand; and
12. WHEREAS, the ASUW Ad-Hoc Parking Committee is scheduled to be dissolved
13. at the end of the 2006-2007 academic year.
14. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of
15. Wyoming (ASUW) that a special committee be formed consisting of at least four
16. (4) senators, two (2) students-at-large and the Director of External Affairs to be
17. established immediately; and
18. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the committee be named the ASUW

19. Transportation and Parking Special Committee; and
20. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the committee be dissolved at the
21. discretion of the Senate no sooner than the 2008-2009 academic year; and
22. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the committee be charged with the
23. following purposes: 1) Provide comments and recommendations to the University
24. of Wyoming Transportation Committee; 2) Research parking issues impacting
25. students on campus; and 3) Explore opportunities to alleviate parking difficulties
26. in the City of Laramie permitted areas.
