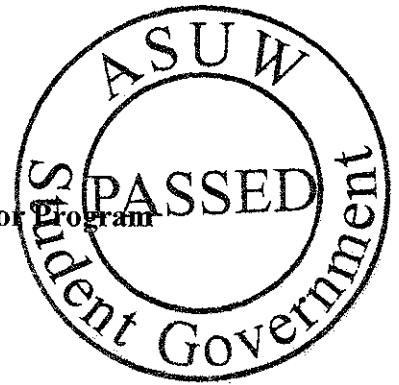


SENATE BILL #2246



**Title:** Full Transference of the ASUW Bike Library to the Outdoor Program


**Sponsors:** Senators Fournier, Jones, Thomas and White

1. WHEREAS, the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW) Student
2. Government currently operates the ASUW Bike Library in coordination with the Outdoor
3. Program, as detailed in an existing memorandum of understanding; and
4. WHEREAS, the current ASUW Student Government administration supports the Outdoor
5. Program and the Campus Recreation department taking over full operation and funding of
6. the Bike Library; and
7. WHEREAS, the Outdoor Program wishes to operate the ASUW Bike Library and a bike
8. shop to service the ASUW Bike Library and provide basic bike-mechanic services that would
9. be available to all UW student cyclists; and
10. WHEREAS, one-time funding from ASUW is needed to complete renovations of Half-Acre
11. Gym to house the new bike shop; and
12. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Student Services Endowment is to finance the enhancement
13. of student services buildings, venues, or other projects at the University of Wyoming as
14. designated by the ASUW Student Government.
15. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
16. University of Wyoming (ASUW) that the ASUW Bike Library be officially transferred to the
17. complete control of the Outdoor Program; and

18. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the existing ASUW Bike Library memorandum of  
19. understanding with the Outdoor Program be dissolved; and  
20. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the ASUW By-Laws be amended to delete the  
21. "Bike Library" from the list of programs under Article 8, Section 1, Subsection C, Paragraph  
22. 1 as outlined in addendum A; and  
23. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that \$20,000 be appropriated from the Student Services  
24. Endowment to the Outdoor Program for the construction of a bike shop within the Half-Acre  
25. Gym.
