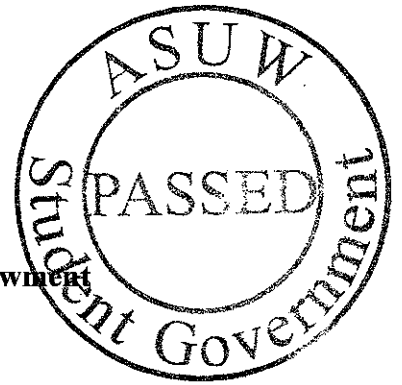


SENATE RESOLUTION #2248



TITLE: Establishment of the A. L. Lupton Financial Literacy Endowment

DATE: April 6, 2009

1. WHEREAS, the Business Manager of the Associated Students of the University of
2. Wyoming (ASUW) provides stability and continuity for students each year; and
3. WHEREAS, ASUW Business Manager A. Lorraine Lupton will retire in 2009 after 21 years
4. of service to ASUW; and
5. WHEREAS, the Student Senate of ASUW would like to show their appreciation for her
6. service and dedication by creating the "A. L. Lupton Financial Literacy Endowment" to be
7. managed by ASUW; and
8. WHEREAS, there is an urgent need for pecuniary literacy among the students on this campus
9. in light of the current economic situation; and
10. WHEREAS, each year the ASUW Director of Finance will coordinate and facilitate
11. educational workshops, lectures, programs and other services regarding effective financial
12. management for students at the University of Wyoming; and
13. WHEREAS, starting an endowment fund requires \$50,000.00.
14. THEREFORE, be it enacted that Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
15. (ASUW) will match the first \$25,000.00 of donations using the RSO Funding Board
16. 2008-2009 budget surplus and the SafeRide 2008-2009 budget surplus to support this
17. endowment.

18. THEREFORE, be it enacted that the appropriation form ASUW be used as matching funds
19. from sources such as private donors, the College of Business, and other entities and
20. organizations from around the state; and
21. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that if \$25,000.00 is not raised by January 2010, the
22. \$25,000.00 from the ASUW budget will not be allocated.
