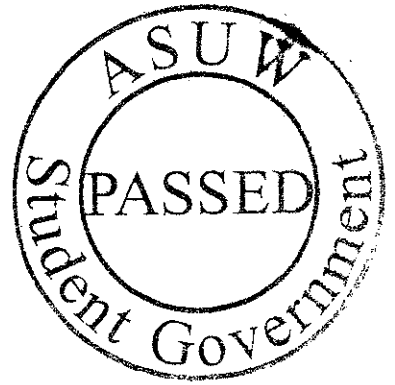


SENATE BILL #2257



TITLE: Special Projects Allocation Act FY '10

DATE: November 6, 2009

AUTHOR: Senator Thomas

SPONSORS: Senators Beman, Mullen, Perryman, Platte, Pottle, and Thomas, Executive Helton, SAL Kaul and Walters

1. WHEREAS, the student senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
2. (ASUW) in fiscal year (FY) '09 allocated \$35,000 for the Special Projects Fund to be
3. expended in FY '10; and
4. WHEREAS, the ASUW Finance Policy states, "the ASUW Endowment may be used for
5. one-time projects that will benefit a large population for several years"; and
6. WHEREAS, the ASUW Budget and Planning Committee has reviewed applications,
7. researched proposals, and determined which projects best meet the specified guidelines.
8. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the student senate of the Associated Students of the
9. University of Wyoming that \$34,804.10 be allocated from the Special Projects Fund to the
10. request outlined in Addendum A.
