

SENATE BILL #2258



TITLE: Student Relations Outreach Act

DATE: October 23, 2009

AUTHOR: Senators Fuentes and Rieser

SPONSORS: Senators Dugas, Fournier, Fuentes, Moran, Rieser and Simpson; Executive Combs

1. WHEREAS, the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming cannot “provide an
2. effective organization to promote the general welfare of all students of the University” or
3. “represent the concerns for the student body,” as outlined in the ASUW Constitution, without
4. an effective outreach program; and
5. WHEREAS, Article II, Section 4, Clause B states that “[The ASUW Senate] shall have the
6. authority to assume whatever responsibilities it deems necessary to fulfill its obligations to
7. the students;” and
8. WHEREAS, ASUW senators will be able to effectively represent the voice of their
9. constituents with direct contact with University of Wyoming students;
10. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that the
11. program outlined in Addendum A be created by the Student Relations Committee under
12. provisions in Article II, Section 10, Subsection A, Clause 8a and 8b and with oversight from
13. the Steering Committee pursuant to Article II, Section 10, Subsection A, Clause 6a and 6b of
14. the ASUW By-Laws.

Addendum A

The Student Relations Committee shall be empowered to create a program wherein every able Senator, with the expressed oral or written permission from each professor, shall be required to make a brief presentation about ASUW and its services to his/her largest class once per semester. Under Article II, Section 10, Subsection A, Clause 6a and 6b, The Steering Committee, with a memorandum of understanding with the ASUW President and Executive Chief of Staff, shall assist in administering and enforcing such a program outlined and administered by the Student Relations Committee.
