

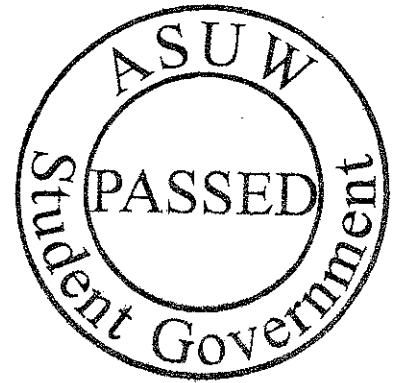
SENATE BILL #2260

TITLE: UW Open Labs Ad Hoc Committee Establishment Act

DATE: December 1, 2009

SPONSORS: Senators Barrett, Beman and Zhang



1. WHEREAS, the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
2. (ASUW) has the authority to create and approve programs for the use and benefits of
3. students; and
4. WHEREAS, University of Wyoming Open Labs (UWOL) shall have broad benefit to
5. students and the university community, shall strive for financial sustainability, shall enhance
6. the educational opportunities, shall have positive local economic impact, and shall be an in
7. house resource to ASUW in fulfilling its mission; and
8. WHEREAS, the project is at a stage where it will require official recognition and support;
9. and;
10. WHEREAS, only officially-recognized ASUW programs, services or affiliated governance
11. groups may submit budget requests to ASUW Student Senate;
12. THEREFORE, be it enacted by ASUW that an ad-hoc committee be created with a
13. composition as outlined in Addendum A, with the charge to form the UWOL governing
14. documents and projected budget no later than 60 calendar days after passage of this bill.
