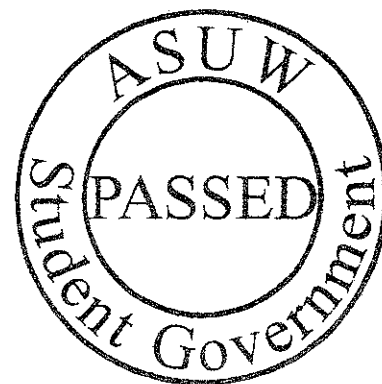


SENATE BILL # 2265



TITLE: ASUW New Senator Orientation

SPONSORS: Senators Fuentes and Wallace; and Vice President Hunzic

1. WHEREAS, first term senators have little to no experience with the Associated Students of
2. the University of Wyoming (ASUW) Senate; and
3. WHEREAS, ASUW Senate meetings require strict adherence to its rules and regulations in
4. order to operate in a timely and efficient manner; and
5. WHEREAS, there is no proper orientation session for newly elected Senators to gain a
6. knowledge of the procedures used during Senate meetings; and
7. WHEREAS, giving an opportunity for new senators to ask questions and develop an
8. understanding of what is required of them during meetings and what to expect from their
9. upcoming term is beneficial to those senators and therefore the colleges they represent;
10. THEREFORE, be it resolved that Article II Section 6 Subsection A be amended to contain
11. the language contained in Addendum A;

ADDENDUM A

6. ASUW Steering Committee:

a. Purpose. The Committee shall provide coordination for the various issues, legislative activities, and program involvements of the ASUW Executive and Legislative branches, and serve to pursue ASUW recommendations and actions that are referred to, or require action by the University Trustees, the faculty, or administrative units of the University. The Committee shall also organize an informational meeting for Senators serving their first term in office before the first meeting of the new Senate.
