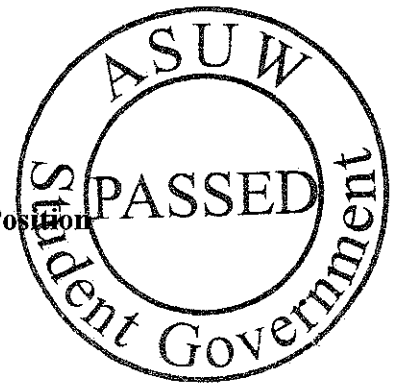


SENATE BILL #2339



SPONSORS: Senators Defebaugh and Hull

1. WHEREAS, the Student Government of the Associated Students of the University of
2. Wyoming (ASUW) is dedicated to providing support to its programs and services; and,
3. WHEREAS, the Associated Students Technical Services (ASTEC) is an ASUW program
4. dedicated to providing electronic, technical, audio, and visual assistance to student
5. programming across campus; and,
6. WHEREAS, the ASTEC Technical Services Coordinator currently uses a majority of
7. specified work time working at events and venues providing integral assistance to student
8. and university employees to deliver the best aforementioned programming; and,
9. WHEREAS, having an individual working solely in the ASTEC Office to help with daily
10. office tasks including answering phones, answering e-mails, fielding questions from visitors,
11. corresponding with ASUW Office Staff, etc. would fulfill responsibilities the ASTEC
12. Technical Services Coordinator is unable to fulfill because of the extremely busy work
13. schedule; and,
14. WHEREAS, the ASUW Reserve Fund "shall be maintained for the purposes of securing
15. the ongoing development of the activities, programs, and advancement of the ideals of the
16. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming."
17. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
18. University of Wyoming (ASUW) that three thousand forty dollars (\$3,040) be allocated from

19. the ASUW Reserve Fund to fund an ASTEC Student Office Aide position for 20 hours per
20. week at \$8.00 an hour for the Spring 2012 semester.
