Request for Interpretation: ASUW Finance Policy, Article 3, Section 3.02, Paragraph 11

Associate Justice Jackson delivered a Concurring Opinion of the Judicial Council's Majority Opinion on November 5th, 2019.

Opinion

The word representative is what is in question. Is any person allowed to be a representative for a Representative Student Organization? A representative is defined as a person chosen or appointed to act or speak for another or others. Having or being represented happens in many capacities of life, and in many cases, the intent of how that representation happens is misinterpreted. The wording in the RSO Section 3.02, Paragraph 11 states is determined to mean that any person that the RSO delegates to act or speak on the RSO's behalf is completely acceptable. With that; the intent of the RSO documents is meant for a current member of the RSO and active student at the University of Wyoming can be the representative for that specific RSO of which they are a member.
