16,033 Traps or Survey Sites have been examined for European Gypsy Moth in 23 Wyoming Counties and Yellowstone National Park

16,033 Traps have been examined:

- 4,507 Traps have been placed by WY USDA APHIS PPQ
- 4,011 Traps have been placed by Wyoming State Forestry
- 1,746 Traps have been placed by National Park Service
- 3,812 Traps have been placed by US Forest Service
 - 12 Traps have been placed by US Forest Service
- 1,424 Traps have been placed by Wyoming Department of Agriculture
 - 501 Traps have been placed by Joint State and Federal Agencies
 - 20 Traps have been placed by City Agencies

16,192 Total Traps have been placed in Wyoming

159 Total Traps have not been recovered:

- 21 Traps have not been recovered by WY USDA APHIS PPQ
- 68 Traps have not been recovered by Wyoming State Forestry
- 20 Traps have not been recovered by National Park Service
- 34 Traps have not been recovered by US Forest Service
