INSTRUCTIONS FOR COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

Application Deadline – February 1, 2017

ELIGIBILITY - To be eligible, applicants must meet the following qualifications:

1. Applicant must be a woman enrolled as an undergraduate or graduate student in an ABET accredited engineering, computing, or engineering technology program (see <http://www.abet.org/> for a list of eligible schools and majors) in Colorado or Wyoming (excluding zip codes 80800-81599, which apply via the Pikes Peak Section). Entering Freshmen (graduating High School Seniors) should complete the "Entering Freshmen" application.
2. Applicant must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
3. Applicant must be able to accept the scholarship for the academic year starting in the Fall of 2017 and must not already be receiving full funding from another organization(s).

GENERAL

1. Three scholarships (\$1,000 minimum) are available. Awardees will be invited to an awards event.
2. All scholarship recipients will be notified by April 20, 2017. Non-recipients will typically not be notified, unless a stamped self-addressed envelope is submitted with the application.
3. No restrictions are placed on applicants with respect to other scholarships, including other SWE scholarships, unless the other scholarships provide full funding.
4. Scholarship recipients must provide their student ID number upon request, for disbursement of funds to the university.

APPLICATION - To be accepted for judging, an applicant must submit all of the following items:

1. **Application Form** - The form must be fully completed and signed.
2. **Supplementary Information/Resume** - Provide as described on the application form, 3 pages maximum.
3. **Applicant Essay** - Essay written by the applicant, not more than one typewritten page in length, and describing one or more of the following:
 - a. Why the applicant chose an engineering major or particular discipline
 - b. What she will accomplish or how she believes she will make a difference as an engineer
 - c. What or who influenced her to study engineering
4. **Transcript** - Official copy of applicant's transcript(s) for the entire enrollment in current and prior college or university. An electronic copy of the official transcript is acceptable.
5. **Reference Letter 1** - Letter of reference from the applicant's department head, an engineering professor, faculty advisor, or employer (engineering related).
6. **Reference Letter 2** - Letter of reference the applicant's department head, an engineering professor, faculty advisor, employer (engineering related), or from another math, science, or technology professor in whose class the applicant is, or has been, enrolled.

Forms must be completed and postmarked no later than February 1st. The transcript and reference letters may be included with the application (preferred) or submitted separately to the address below. *The applicant is responsible for seeing that all the necessary information and documents are submitted by the deadline.* An incomplete application package will be disqualified.
