Thank you for taking the time to review this application. We accept scholarship applications from students at the following universities: Brigham Young, Colorado School of Mines, Colorado State, Colorado (Boulder and Denver), Metro State, Utah, South Dakota School of Mines, and Wyoming. The GPA Midstream Association is a trade association with primary membership being employees of companies who are involved in the gathering, processing, marketing, and transportation of natural gas, natural gas liquids, and crude oil as well as companies which supply equipment and services for this market.

The Rocky Mountain Chapter of the Gas Processors Association is pleased to announce plans to award multiple scholarships up to \$5,000. In addition, top award winners receiving a \$5,000 scholarship will also receive a copy of GPSA data books on CD-ROM. In 2016, we awarded \$25,000 to students attending the universities listed above.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. The student has demonstrated a strong interest in the Oil and Gas Processing Industry.
2. The student is maintaining a 2.8 or better Grade Point Average (4.0 scale).
3. The student has reached the third year at their respective University in the undergraduate program.
4. The student is a U.S. citizen.

Potential candidates must complete the application and required essay. The essay (1,000 word maximum) should focus on the candidate's interest in the oil and gas processing industry and how the candidate expects to use their degree in this industry. Our Scholarship Committee will review applications and essays and make a final decision in late October. Please note that verification of submitted Grade Point Average (GPA) may be requested from selected applicants.
