

POLICY ON ENFORCEMENT OF PREREQUISITE CHANGES

From time to time, course prerequisites will be changed. When such a change occurs, the new prerequisite will not be retroactively applied to courses the student has completed and passed, nor shall it be applied to courses in which the student is currently enrolled. The new prerequisite shall be applied to any course in which the student enrolls after the date the new prerequisite is adopted.

Date policy becomes effective: September 5, 2018

Policy affects enrollment in courses starting Fall semester, 2019.

Example:

A student starts the B.S. in Chemical Engineering program Fall semester, 2015, and is following the 2015/2016 curriculum. During Spring semester, 2019, this student wishes to enroll in CHE 4090 Fall Semester, 2019.

Prerequisite for CHE 4090 in the 2015/2016 curriculum: CHE 3028 and CHE 4060

Prerequisite for CHE 4090 according to the 2018/2019 catalog: C- or better in CHE 3028 and CHE 4060

In this case, the latter prerequisite requirements will be enforced. If the student earned a D in either CHE 3028 or CHE 4060, then that student would not be permitted to enroll in CHE 4050.
