Thank you for your interest in the Play Therapy Online Graduate Certificate at the University of Wyoming. Courses in this certificate program are taught in a completely online format comprised of both asynchronous and synchronous components (such as meeting face-to-face via Zoom). The purpose of the online graduate certificate program is to meet the 150 clock training hours required by the Association for Play Therapy (APT) to become a Registered Play Therapist (RPT) or a School-Based Registered Play Therapist (SB-RPT). The program is designed for completion in one academic year with cohort groups beginning annually in the fall semester. This 7-hour graduate level certificate program meets the academic content hours requirement for participants.

Some important information regarding the certificate program:

- A master's degree or higher mental health degree from an institution of higher education is required for acceptance to this graduate certificate program.
- Participants are also responsible for meeting the additional requirements outlined by APT (https://www.a4pt.org/page/CredentialsHomepage)
- The application deadline for the next cohort for the certificate program is July 1, for the fall term beginning mid to late August.

- Once accepted into the online play therapy certificate program, students are required to complete three graduate level courses in play therapy totaling 7 credit hours of graduate level work which is designed to meet the 150 clock hours of training (the academic content hours portion) required by the Association for Play Therapy (APT) as a part of the process for applying to become a Registered Play Therapist (RPT) or a School-Based Registered Play Therapist (SB-RPT).
