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17 11. UNIVERSITY COURSE REVIEW COMMITTEE
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19 a. Rationale

20 The University Course Review Committee is established to monitor and implement the University course
21 review process as described in UW Regulation 6-806, Section 2, Part e.
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23 b. Functions

24 When considering course additions, revisions or deletions to the University curriculum, the University
25 Course Review Committee shall be responsible for insuring that all of the requisite endorsements have
26 been obtained (UW Regulation 6-806, Section 2, Part d.), that the proposal does not present any
27 unjustified duplication with other academic units, and that the request is consistent with the current
28 University guidelines regarding courses. The University Course Review Committee is additionally
29 charged with the development and maintenance of the Course Review Guidelines (see UW Regulation 6-
30 806, Section 2, Parts f. through i.), and with the routine examination and maintenance of the Course
31 Review Process itself.
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33 c. Powers

34 The University Course Review Committee shall make its recommendations relating to the addition,
35 revision, and deletion of courses to the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs. These
36 recommendations will be rendered in the context of the University's comprehensive development. In
37 making these recommendations, the University Course Review Committee will take into consideration
38 the Wyoming community colleges and the educational needs of the State of Wyoming as well as
39 University considerations. All committee actions will be reported to the Faculty Senate regularly.
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41 d. Composition

42 The University Course Review Committee will consist of the representatives from each of the seven
43 colleges. Each college will select its own representative along with an alternate. If representation from
44 any of these colleges cannot be found, then the Committee on Committees is directed to select members
45 in as representational fashion as possible. The Chair of the University Studies Committee, the Chair of the
46 Graduate Council, the Registrar, the Dean of the Libraries, the Dean of the Outreach School, the
47 Director of the American Heritage Center, an ASUW representative, and the Coordinator of Community
48 College Articulation shall be *ex officio* members without vote. The Chair is an *ex officio* member of the
49 Academic Planning Committee and the Executive Committee of the Faculty Senate.
