6 **A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF**  
7 **The University of Wyoming’s NSF ADVANCE Proposal**

10 **WHEREAS**, according to University of Wyoming Regulation 6-701, “the Faculty  
11 Senate shall seek to determine and establish educational and academic policies which  
12 promote and protect the interests and welfare of the University community and further the  
13 full and free development and preservation of scholarly learning, teaching, and research”;  
14 and

16 **WHEREAS**, the NSF ADVANCE program is focused on “increasing the participation  
17 and advancement of women in academic science and engineering careers”; and  
18

19 **WHEREAS**, Principal Investigator Snehalata Huzurbuzar and Co-Principal  
20 Investigators Cynthia Weinig, Anna Zajacova, and Eva Ferre-Pikal are actively preparing a  
21 NSF ADVANCE Proposal for the University of Wyoming as outlined in the attached  
22 addendum; and

24 **WHEREAS**, addressing appropriate University of Wyoming policies, procedures, and  
25 practices related to implicit bias, work-life balance, and environmental conditions for  
26 advancement as outlined in the attached addendum have the potential to “promote and  
27 protect the interest and welfare of the University community”; and

29 **WHEREAS** the NSF ADVANCE Proposal has received support from multiple faculty  
30 and administrators at the University of Wyoming; therefore

32 **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Faculty Senate of the University of Wyoming supports  
33 UW’s NSF ADVANCE Proposal as outlined in the attached addendum; and

35 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Faculty Senate of the University of Wyoming  
36 consider all recommendations under its authority that result from the NSF ADVANCE  
37 Proposal.
