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3 **A Bill to Revise UW Regulation 6-700,**
4 ***Bylaws of the University Faculty***
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6 **WHEREAS**, at the September 2016 Board of Trustees meeting, the Board approved review by UW
7 administration of UW’s current regulatory structure, to include the following:

- 8 1) Phasing out presidential directives;
9 2) Defining regulation versus policy/procedure;
10 3) Creating an online manual, including a new “look” and format for the regulations; and
11 4) Updating the substance of the regulations, policies, and procedures as needed, including
12 determining whether there are any substantive gaps; and
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14 **WHEREAS**, the new structure will involve three levels of policies:

- 15 1) Governing Regulations (Level A),
16 2) Standard Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level B), and
17 3) Department/Unit Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level C); and
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19 **WHEREAS**, responsibility to modify UW Regulation 6-700 has been tasked to the Faculty Senate; and
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21 **WHEREAS**, to modify UW Regulation 6-700, approval must be by the University Faculty as defined
22 in the regulation; and
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24 **WHEREAS**, the Faculty Senate has taken the responsibility to draft changes to UW Regulation 6-700
25 for consideration by the University Faculty; and
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27 **WHEREAS**, the Faculty Senate proposed modifications are attached to this Senate Bill; and
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29 **WHEREAS**, the Faculty Senate will work with the President as the Presiding Officer of the University
30 Faculty to conduct an email vote, according to the intent of UW Regulation 6-700, for University Faculty
31 consideration of the proposed changes to UW Regulation 6-700;
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33 **THEREFORE**, be it enacted that with University Faculty approval of the proposed changes to UW
34 Regulation 6-700, including any University Faculty approved amendments, the Faculty Senate will deem
35 UW Regulation 6-700 modified as approved by the University Faculty.
