5 **RESOLUTION IN FAVOR OF**
6 **FACULTY SENATE ENDORSEMENT OF**
7 **PROPOSED DEGREE IN CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT**

10 **WHEREAS**, the Academic Planning Committee (APC) reviewed a proposed Bachelor
11 of Science (BS) degree in Construction Management; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the APC approved the proposal with a proviso that the number of
14 required courses to be closer to that of peer institutions so it is more likely that University
15 of Wyoming students pursuing the degree will graduate in four years; and

16
17 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Civil and Architectural Engineering responded by
18 reducing the number of required courses so that 120 is the total number of credits
19 required for a BS degree in Construction Management; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the offering meets the goal of the 2017 – 2022 University of Wyoming
22 Strategic Plan to address workforce needs of our state and region; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the current draft curriculum meets the standards for accreditation by
25 the American Council for Construction Education (ACCE); therefore,

27 **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Faculty Senate:

29 Approves the recommendations contained in the 10 August 2018 feasibility study to
30 establish a BS degree in Construction Management in the Department of Civil and
31 Architectural Engineering at the University of Wyoming, attached.
